Erupting Diy Paint Recipe

What you'll need

- Vinegar
- Food Coloring
- Paper
- Baking soda
- Flour
- Paint Brushes

Steps

1. In a muffin tin, mix all of the ingredients for one color per hole together.

Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons of flour
- 1 tablespoon of baking soda
- A few drops of food coloring or paint
- A bit of water

- 5. Let your kids lightly spray their art with the vinegar in the bottles to make it fizz
